PROTOCOL TO PREVENT AND CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 VIRUS

This document is an integral part of the campsite's internal rules and regulations and contains the main guidelines to facilitate the conduct of the various activities. In fact, the continuation of the activities can only take place under conditions that ensure an adequate level of protection for our guests and staff. Failure by the guest to comply with the protocol may result in denial of access to Tenuta Squaneto. In fact, in the worst case this may lead to the suspension of the activities of the campsite by regulatory bodies until security is restored.

IN COMPLYING WITH THESE RULES!!

By means of additional information in the most appropriate places, we inform guests as well as suppliers and staff about the measures to be taken.

Anyone entering the company can be subjected to body temperature control. If this temperature exceeds 37.5°, access will not be permitted. In case of possible suspicion of contamination, we urge you to inform the management.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

During the full occupancy of the campsite, our buildings are cleaned thoroughly twice a day as standard. Even with the current maximum occupancy of 50%, we maintain this frequency.

Every day the standard checks of the sanitary facilities will be carried out with special attention to the usual procedures for the prevention and control of legionella infection.

The daily cleaning will be carried out with the use of neutral detergents but also by means of disinfectants. Disinfectant gel dispensers are installed at the entrance to the main buildings, make good use of them.

It is mandatory that everyone takes all necessary hygienic precautions, even within their own accommodation. We recommend the importance of fresh air and the regular washing of hands and cleaning of surfaces with suitable cleaning agents.

PERSONAL PROTECTION

Guests (from 6 years of age) must always use a mouth mask when they are outside their own pitch and when it is not possible to guarantee the interpersonal distance of at least one meter. Exceptions are persons who are not subject to interpersonal distance according to the applicable rules (e.g. members of the same household). We count on the individual responsibility of each and every one of them.

COMMUNAL AREAS

Access to the communal areas shall be permitted for a limited period of time while maintaining a safety distance of at least 1 metre between persons. Movements within these areas shall be limited to the minimum necessary. Gathering is strictly forbidden.

SWIMMING POOL

Subject to the rules that also impose social distance of at least 1 meter in the pool, access to the entire area will be regulated up to a maximum number of people present. Wearing a bathing cap is mandatory.

Reservations can be made for the following time blocks.

9.00 a.m. - 11.45 a.m.

12.00 a.m. - 14.45 p.m.

15.00 p.m. - 17.45 p.m.

18.00 p.m. - 19.00 p.m.

Reservations can be made at the bar.

Maximum 35 persons per time block. Maximum 1 reservation per day.

A nice alternative is a refreshing dip in the river around the campsite!

RESTAURANT

For delicious meals you can visit our terrace, but we kindly ask you to reserve your table in advance.

The tables will be set up in such a way that the seats guarantee the interpersonal distance between those present.

Persons from different households can only sit at the same table after filling in a declaration of personal responsibility regarding the group composition.

Inside, the use of a mouth mask is mandatory if you are not seated at the table.

In case of bad weather during the pizza evenings (Tuesday, Friday and Sunday) only take-away pizzas are sold!

WASTE COLLECTION

We ask you, especially in view of the COVID emergency, to carry out the separate collection as well as possible, so that we can also guarantee our employees minimal contact with your waste. Sort your waste and only dispose of it when really necessary. Do not dispose of used masks separately, but in sealed bags.
