

## **Camping regulations**

Access to the campsite is granted upon approval from the management.

You are expected to present an identification document upon arrival for registration and to have fulfilled your payment obligations.

The campsite pitch will be assigned by the management. You must set up within the assigned area and not make changes to the pitch without the management's permission.

To ensure the peace and privacy of fellow campers, it is not allowed to stay with multiple families/households at one pitch or in one accommodation.

Your arrival must be reported to the management before entering the campsite, as well as your departure.

Complaints can be submitted to the management with justification.

The management is not liable for damages caused by natural phenomena.

You are responsible for your belongings. The management is not liable for loss or theft.

Noise-producing equipment must be kept at low volume at all times. Air conditioning in caravans or campers must be turned off during the night. Quiet hours are between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

To promote necessary peace and safety, the campsite is considered a residential area for all traffic. This means that only slow speeds, max. 5 km/h, are allowed.

The use of cars is prohibited in the car-free area (pitch 27–35). You are expected to use the designated parking areas along the field.

Your waste must be separated into the designated containers.

Keep the grounds, buildings, inventory, and landscaping clean and do not damage them. We reserve the right to hold you liable for any damage caused.

Barbecuing is only allowed with the management's permission.

Dogs are only allowed on a leash. The area around the swimming pool is off-limits for dogs.

Ball games are only to be played in the designated fields.

Children are expected to be accompanied by their parents when entering various buildings and facilities. Parents are deemed responsible for their children, and the management disclaims any liability in this regard.

Swimming and fishing in the pond on the campsite are strictly prohibited.

Any contagious disease or virus must be reported to the management.

Access to the campsite means full acceptance and knowledge of these rules, which have been established by the management to improve the functioning of the campsite. The campsite staff is authorized to monitor compliance with the rules and report to the management.

These house rules are not intended to restrict your freedom but to keep the holiday park pleasant and livable. We rely on compliance. This will enhance your stay and that of others at our holiday park.
